### **6. What does the property owner have to do in regard to the new sewerage scheme?**

Arrange prompt connection of plumbing from the house to the sewer

Arrange decommissioning of septic tank

Arrange decommissioning grease trap

Where possible use water efficient appliance and practices

Use low phosphorus detergents

### **7. How much will it cost the property owner**

\$800.00 scheme contribution to South Gippsland Water. Plumbing costs to connect from the sewer main to the house and decommission existing infrastructure.

*\*NOTE: the pipe work from the sewer main to the house is the owners responsibility. Installation and any future maintenance costs are not covered by South Gippsland Water.*

### **8. What is the scheme time- line?**

December 2009	- Seek public comment for the draft reticulation system
May 2010	- Finalise design of reticulation, pumping stations and rising mains
	- Select treatment plant site
	- Invite construction tenders
October 2010	- Construction commences
June 2013	- Scheme completed
