WATER STORAGES STILL GOOD

Rainfall recorded last week at South Gippsland Waters storages was – Lance Creek [not available] mm, Ruby Creek 15mm, Coalition Creek 17.4mm, Deep Creek 20mm, Little Bass 13.4mm and Battery Creek 57.5mm.

Steve Evans, Managing Director of South Gippsland Water, said today, “All storages are at good levels for this time of the year and river systems are flowing satisfactorily.”

South Gippsland Water will still continue to closely monitor all systems as the season progresses.
