WATER STORAGES FILLING

Rainfall recorded at South Gippsland Waters storages last week was – Lance Creek 28mm, Ruby Creek 17mm, Coalition Creek 25mm, Deep Creek 11mm, Little Bass 11mm and Battery Creek - not available.

Steve Evans, Managing Director of South Gippsland Water, said today, “Storage levels are rising and are very satisfactory for this time of the year.”

South Gippsland Water will still continue to closely monitor all systems as the season progresses.
