WATER STORAGES RECOVERING WELL

Rainfall recorded at South Gippsland Waters storages last week was – Lance Creek 30mm, Ruby Creek 26mm, Coalition Creek 31mm, Deep Creek 31mm, Little Bass 34mm and Battery Creek 31mm.

Steve Evans, Managing Director of South Gippsland Water, said today, “Storage levels are recovering well and are very satisfactory for this time of the year.”
