- 8) If a structure is permitted, a Deed or Agreement will be prepared and sent for signing which will include the Standard Conditions for Approval, and any special conditions that may apply.
- 9) South Gippsland Water may refuse this application if it becomes evident that any information or supporting documents provided are incomplete or false.
- 10) Failure to obtain SGW approval prior to commencement of works may constitute an offence under section 148 of the Water Act 1989.
