### **Can the project be in any area?**

Grants will be given to projects within the South Gippsland Water Region.

The water efficient component of the project.

### **What is a water efficient component?**

Any area of your project that saves water.

### **How much money can we get?**

The grant amount is determined by quotations supplied in the application process. Maximum amount is \$500.00.

### **How will the money be paid?**

Once an application is approved H4O funds to the agreed value will be provided on receipt or invoice. Supplier ABN numbers must be provided.
