Rainfall recorded at South Gippsland Water's storages from the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2014 to 12<sup>th</sup> September 2014 was 11mm at Lance Creek, 20mm at Ruby Creek, 25mm at Coalition Creek, 19mm at Deep Creek, 22mm at Little Bass and 36mm at Battery Creek.
