Little Rainfall Impacts Water Storages And River Flow

Little rainfall was recorded at South Gippsland Water's storages from **27th of February 2016 to 4th of March 2016**. Lance Creek 0mm, Ruby Creek 0mm, Coalition Creek 0mm, Deep Creek 1mm, Little Bass 0mm and Battery Creek 0mm.

Stage 1 water restrictions apply to South Gippsland Water customers in Korumburra, Poowong, Loch and Nyora) and Stage 2 water restrictions now apply to customers in Fish Creek.

Flow in the Tarwin River has dropped below 20 ML/day. Under the current bulk entitlement agreement to provide supplementary water from the river to the Korumburra water supply system, extraction of water from the river was stopped on Friday 4 March.

Justin Wightman, Acting Managing Director, South Gippsland Water said, "When needed, pumping from the Tarwin provides an alternate water supply to augment the Korumburra system. The bulk entitlement ensures that when flow levels drop, pumping from the river stops; it's a measure that's in place to protect water quality and river health."

"The Corporation will continue to closely monitor water storages and river flow over the coming weeks," added Mr Wightman. "Higher level restrictions for the Korumburra system will be activated if required."
