Rainfall And Storage Update

Rainfall was recorded at South Gippsland Water's storages from **9**th **April to 15**th **April 2016**. Lance Creek 9mm, Ruby Creek 4mm, Coalition Creek 9mm, Deep Creek 3mm, Little Bass 7mm and Battery Creek 18mm.

Philippe du Plessis, Managing Director, South Gippsland Water said, "The Corporation continues to monitor all storages closely, in particular the systems with Stage Two Water Restrictions in place – Battery Creek (Fish Creek), Coalition Creek (Korumburra), and Little Bass (Poowong, Loch and Nyora)."

"Given low rainfall forecasts and continued demand for water, it is likely that Stage 3 Water Restrictions will be implemented for the Little Bass water supply system toward the end of this month."

"We urge all customers to continue to use household water wisely as storage levels continue to drop."
