Rainfall Keeps Water Storages Steady

Rainfall was recorded at South Gippsland Water's storages from 14th May – 20th May 2016. Lance Creek 23mm, Ruby Creek 8mm, Coalition Creek 18mm, Deep Creek 6mm, Little Bass 16mm and Battery Creek 14mm.

The rainfall eased the impact of demand on storages over the past week. Overall, levels in most storages remained steady, with the Little Bass water supply system recording a 2% increase and Ruby Creek dropping by only 1%.

The Corporation continues to monitor all water storages closely, particularly the Ruby Creek Water Supply System and the currently restricted Battery Creek, Coalition Creek and Little Bass water supply systems.

Planned increases to water restrictions for Korumburra, Poowong, Loch and Nyora will be assessed on an ongoing basis, enabling the Corporation to respond to changes in weather conditions and customer demand for water.

Philippe du Plessis, Managing Director, South Gippsland Water said, "The Ruby Creek Water Supply System is close to Stage 1 water restrictions, but at this time of year they will have little to no impact on overall water demand."

"It's likely that Stage 1 restrictions for Leongatha will be by-passed and that Stage 2 water restrictions will be implemented if storage levels fall further.

"The timing for Stage 2 restrictions is difficult to predict but would most likely not occur until mid to late June, however, this will be influenced by levels of rainfall in the meantime."

Given current reservoir levels, the need to escalate restrictions will be reviewed on a week by week basis. South Gippsland Water encourages customers to use water wisely and adhere to the permanent water savings rules and restriction levels currently in place.
