Storage and Rainfall Update

Rainfall was recorded at South Gippsland Water's storages from **8**th – **14**th **October 2016**. Lance Creek 17mm, Ruby Creek 40mm, Coalition Creek 34mm, Deep Creek 36mm, Little Bass 58mm and Battery Creek 34mm.

All six water storages continue at 100% capacity. Lance Creek 4200 ML, Ruby Creek 1910 ML, Coalition Creek 575 ML, Deep Creek 238 ML, Little Bass 219 ML and Battery Creek 122 ML.

Spring rainfall is keeping catchments and reservoirs topped-up and well prepared for summer; all systems are where they should be for this time of year.
